Michael Snow's 1967 *Wavelength* is a beautiful and disconcerting study of space. The experience of a New York City loft is inexorably framed by the artist's masterful use of the "long zoom." In the 2003 remix, *WVLNT* (*Wavelength for Those Who Don't Have the Time*), Snow transforms his original, spatial investigation into a meditation of surface and translucency that speaks to the media saturated world in which we live.
